Home Learning

The Government has recently introduced the requirement that all schools provide home learning for children who are having to self-isolate for COVID 19 reasons. We have therefore been looking at how we can extend and improve our offer. We have decided to introduce a home learning platform called 'Purple Mash', which will allow teachers to upload lessons and work for children who need to self-isolate. Purple Mash will also make it easier for teachers both to monitor, and give feedback on, the work that children have submitted. Please ensure that you have completed the consent form, which is being sent home with your child.

COVID 19.

If any member of your household develops COVID 19 symptoms please ensure that you book a test. All members of the household, including all children must self-isolate until the test result is received. A negative result means that your child can return to school (unless they have been identified as a close contact of someone who has tested positive for COVID 19). A positive result means your child must self-isolate at home for 14 days from the onset of their symptoms or 14 days from the test date if the household member had no symptoms.
