






























# Sustainable Development Goals (SDG)

World leaders met in September 2015 to agree on the plan to take action on issues that affect millions of people across the planet. The discussion led to them creating and agreeing on 17 Global Goals. The goals target specific issues such as gender inequality and poverty, as well as more general areas such as life below water and on land.

At Swan Lane, as well as discussing the Goals in whole school assemblies, we have linked these goals to our Curriculum. For example, Year 2 learn about Materials in Science and this is inked to SDG 12 Responsible Consumption . They learn about the importance of recycling plastics. In PSHE, Year 3 consider SDG 5 Gender Equality during the Changing Me unit. They learn about the importance of gender equality and consider some of the inequalities that still exist in today's World Follow the link for more child-friendly information...


